

MINUTES  
BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB

APRIL 23, 2008

Concerning the spirit sign project for the fieldhouse, Aaron Duell announced that he is still waiting to receive information back from Salina.

Concerning the concessions for softball and baseball, Colleen Duell announced it was going good and there are enough supplies to finish out the year. She further announced that a refrigerator had to be purchased for the stand and the Bonsalls will pay the club \$50 in

May for one-half of the cost for the refrigerator, as they use the stand for summer ball games.

Concerning the sign on the north side of the interstate which says, "GHS Home of the Cowboys", it was reported that Stucco had put the sign up years ago and it is badly faded and hard to read. It was moved and seconded to contact Kevin Bauman, as he is a local businessman, to make a new sign or refurbish the old sign with a limit of \$250 maximum.

**New Business:** FCCLA members, Julica Bonsall, Brennan Clouse, Michael Pettibone and Shelby Hall did a presentation for the club concerning their National FCCLA Conference coming up July 13-17, 2008. It was moved and seconded to give each of the four members attending the conference \$200 to help with expenses, including \$200 for Mrs. Short as a sponsor, for a grand total of \$1,000.

Brad announced the scholarship committee met and chose five students to receive a \$250 scholarship each from the club. Two alternates were also chosen which the committee felt should also receive \$250 scholarships. It was moved and seconded to also give the two alternates scholarships. The names of the seven recipients will be announced at graduation.

Sarah Short announced that she and Steve Duell will get the food and other items ordered for the soap scrimmage coming up in August. Sarah will also take care of the advertising. It was discussed to keep the price of each plate at \$3.00.
