

MINUTES
BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB

AUGUST 20, 2007

The regular meeting of the Black and Gold Booster Club was held on August 20, 2007, at 5:55 P.M. in the High School cafeteria. The meeting was called to order by President, Brad Schields. Seven members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer, Steve Duell, announced the Treasurer's Report with an ending balance of \$6,759.02. It was moved and seconded to approve the same as presented.

Correspondence: President, Brad Schields, announced the club had received thank you cards from Emily Linden and Tyler Hillmer for their scholarship money and the FCCLA club for funds provided to them by our club.

Old Business: Concerning signage for the junior high gym, Mr. Smith will pursue getting approval from the school board to go ahead and display the sign. Once approved, the club will complete with a cost up to \$500.

Concerning the concessions for baseball and softball, it was announced by Brad Schields that it went well for the club.

It was announced that Tyler Hillmer still has not picked his scholarship money up and the club is still waiting on a copy of his college schedule.

New Business: Concerning the upcoming soap scrimmage on Friday, Brad Schields announced that Mrs. Short ordered the meat and Wilkens Truck and Trailer will donate the chips. Short & Son will provide the condiments. Coca-Cola will bring a fountain machine and serve drinks. The club will owe money for the ads put in the newspaper and on the TV. The club will also need to pay the bread

man (Sara Lee) the amount of \$39.60 for buns. It was moved and seconded to pay the amounts due the newspaper and TV when the bills come in, as well as pay Sara Lee the amount of \$39.60.

It was discussed to sell the remaining shirts at the scrimmage as well as the first two home games. Additional memberships would be sold then as well. The club will hand out decals and pocket calendars with each new membership.

Mr. Smith announced that parents are asking for some help feeding the Hugoton football team because of the distance they have to travel to come here. It was discussed that food could be served at the fieldhouse and work out of the concession area there. The Booster Club would help. Parents will donate the meat. The game is October 19th.

There was discussion concerning the scholarships that the Booster Club currently gives out in April of each year. Currently the club draws five names from a list of students with a 3.2 or higher GPA. It was discussed, instead of drawing the names, the students would fill out an application. It would be put on the school website with the other scholarships and also the Booster Club website. A committee of Brad Schields, Colleen Duell and Fred Hall will bring back ideas for criteria for receiving the scholarships.

There was discussion from the club concerning the following committees:

Membership: Brad Schields announced that Tom and Lisa Tomsic donated the membership applications for the club to use.

Merchandise: Brad Schields announced that he is working on getting more pocket calendars.

Spirit and Hospitality: No discussion.

Ways and Means: Mr. Smith announced that the conference room chairs are still in the same condition and are needing reupholstered.
