

MINUTES  
BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB

DECEMBER 17, 2007

The regular meeting of the Black and Gold Booster Club was held on December 17, 2007, at 6:30 P.M. in the High School cafeteria. The meeting was called to order by President, Brad Schields. Seven members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** The Treasurer's Report was read by Brad Schields, in Treasurer Steve Duell's absence, with an ending balance of \$13,899.02. It was moved and seconded to approve the same as presented. It was moved and seconded to pay the total amount of \$71.89 to Colleen Duell for buying the supplies.

**New Business:** It was moved and seconded to give a \$50 gift certificate from Crazy R's to Steve and Colleen Duell for all of their hard work in the Topside concession stand this year. It was also moved and seconded to pay Kelly Studer the amount of \$50 for purchasing the gift certificate.

Brad announced he had received requests for \$50 donations from the girls' track, football, boys' track, the class of 2008 and AFS. It was moved and seconded to pay each of the five organizations their \$50 donation. After further discussion, it was moved and

seconded to pay AFS an additional \$52.38 (the money will be used for purchasing yearbooks for each of the two foreign exchange students at a cost of \$51.19 each).

Brad announced he had spoken with Hot Brush about making a sign for inside of the fieldhouse directing people to the junior high gym. It was moved and seconded to have Hot Brush make the sign at a cost not to exceed \$250.

There was discussion from the club concerning the following committees:

**Membership:** No discussion.

**Merchandise:** Brad Schields announced that \$212 was sold during Topside and the club has approximately \$612 left in clothing. Brad further announced he has an additional check for \$29 for clothing to deposit.

**Spirit and Hospitality:** No discussion.

**Ways and Means:** Brad announced he sent a thank-you to everyone for helping at Topside.
