

MINUTES
BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB

FEBRUARY 18, 2008

The regular meeting of the Black and Gold Booster Club was held on February 18, 2008, at 6:30 P.M. in the High School ITV room. The meeting was called to order by President, Brad Schields. Nine members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Colleen Duell announced the Treasurer's Report, in Treasurer, Steve Duell's absence, with an ending balance of \$6,433.69. Colleen announced that several \$50 donations had been paid to various clubs and organizations requesting the same, as well as \$25 to the Dennis Stone Memorial and \$150.22 to Hot Brush for the new sign hanging in the fieldhouse directing people to the Junior High Gym. Finally, \$5,000 has been placed in a CD at Bankwest. It was moved and seconded to approve the same as presented.

Old Business: There was further discussion concerning the reupholstering of the conference room chairs. Bill Finley has asked for the remaining chairs to finish over a weekend or two. Brad Schields and Steve Duell will get together and take the chairs to Bill by this weekend. There are six chairs all together to reupholster.

Concerning the sign for the inside of the fieldhouse directing people to the junior high gym, Brad Schields announced Hot Brush is finished with the sign and it has been hung. The cost for the sign was \$150.22.

Concerning the spirit sign project for the fieldhouse, Aaron Duell is checking on some prices of a new electronic sign and will get back to us. The electronic sign currently in the fieldhouse was

purchased by Bankwest for \$8,500 and runs on a DOS program and is therefore outdated. It was discussed about possibly splitting the cost of a new sign between the Black and Gold Booster Club, Alumni, Topside Tipoff and Bankwest.

New Business: Don Smith requested \$50 for the Girls' Basketball. It was moved and seconded to give \$50 to the Girls' Basketball.

There was discussion concerning the concessions for softball and baseball. Colleen Duell volunteered to help with the baseball concessions. Brad Schields will send out an email to the members to see if anyone would be interested in helping with the concessions for softball.

There was discussion concerning forming a scholarship committee for the scholarships the club gives out each year. Colleen Duell, Brad Schields, Mary Porterfield, Charlene Mangus and Kelly Studer will be on the committee.

There was discussion concerning upcoming state events, the send-off times and the number of students qualifying for t-shirts:
