

MINUTES  
BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB

JANUARY 21, 2008

The regular meeting of the Black and Gold Booster Club was held on January 21, 2008, at 6:30 P.M. in the High School cafeteria. The meeting was called to order by President, Brad Schields. Seven members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer, Steve Duell, announced the Treasurer's Report with an ending balance of \$11,958.91. It was moved and seconded to approve the same as presented. Steve announced the club had made a profit at Topside of \$3,080.36. Brad Schields announced he had received a check from sponsor, Overhead Door, in the amount of \$150 for shirts which were thrown out to the crowd by the cheerleaders at the games.

**Correspondence:** Brad Schields read a thank-you note to the club from the cheerleaders for helping to promote spirit.

**Old Business:** There was further discussion concerning the reupholstering of the conference room chairs. Bill Finley has been working on one chair as an example and will finish all of them at once if they can all be taken to him to finish over a weekend sometime. Mary Porterfield announced that there were six chairs all together to reupholster.

Concerning the sign for the inside of the fieldhouse directing people to the junior high gym, Brad Schields announced Hot Brush is still coming up with a price and will get back to us.

Concerning the \$50 donations the club gives out to the organizations, Mary Porterfield will send out a reminder letter for everyone to get their requests in by February 1, 2008, by mailing their requests to the Black and Gold Booster Club at P.O. Box 25, Goodland.

**New Business:** Brad Schields announced he had been asked if the Booster Club could come up with a spirit sign to hang at the fieldhouse. There was discussion about the electronic sign already hanging in the fieldhouse and why it was not being used. Colleen Duell will check with Aaron Duell, who previously worked with the sign, about what might need to be done to get the sign up and running, and then the club possibly providing money each year to maintain the sign. Colleen will get back with us regarding some ideas and a possible committee to be in charge of the sign.

There was discussion concerning the scholarships the club gives out each year and possibly increasing the number given out and/or the dollar amount given out each year. It was decided to wait and see how many applications the club received and then make a decision at that time. The club would adjust accordingly each year.

There was discussion concerning placing some of the club's money into a CD to earn some interest. Treasurer, Steve Duell, will check with the bank and get back to the club.

There was discussion concerning sending money for the Dennis Stone Memorial. It was moved and seconded to give \$25 for the memorial.

There was discussion from the club concerning the following committees:

**Membership:** No discussion.

**Merchandise:** Brad Schields announced that he has approximately \$600 left in clothing. There was discussion concerning getting sponsors to donate money for the cheerleaders to throw out some shirts to the crowd at the games. Brad will ask some people if they would be interested in sponsoring.

**Ways and Means:** No discussion.
