

MINUTES
BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB

SEPTEMBER 17, 2007

The regular meeting of the Black and Gold Booster Club was held on September 17, 2007, at 6:30 P.M. in the High School cafeteria. The meeting was called to order by President, Brad Schields. Eight members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer, Steve Duell, announced the Treasurer's Report with an ending balance of \$11,467.42. It was moved and seconded to approve the same as presented. Brad Schields announced he had received bills from the Prints and Paper in the amount of \$50.01; GTM Sportwear in the amount of \$203; and Western Associates for 275 stickers in the amount of \$402.51. It was moved and seconded to pay the three bills.

Correspondence: President, Brad Schields, announced the club had received thank you cards from Matthew Miller for his scholarship money and Don Smith on behalf of the activity account, for the mini DVD camcorder the club helped purchase.

Old Business: Colleen Duell announced she had prepared a scholarship outline and presented it to the club for review. It was approved and seconded for Colleen to present the outline to Nancy Farris to hand out to the students in April.

Don Smith asked permission to do a "thank you" to the Booster Club and Kiwanis at half time of Friday night's football game. Brad Schields said he would get representatives from both groups to be present.

Concerning signage for the junior high gym, Colleen Duell announced the letters are in and Steve Duell will get with Kenny Studer to see about the display.

There was earlier discussion to help with a meal to feed the Hugoton football team as well as the Goodland football team on October 19th. It was decided to use the High School cafeteria and the football parents will serve the meal to approximately 140 people, 60 from Hugoton and 75 from Goodland. The Terry Taylor family will provide the meat; the Jim Mosbarger family will provide the paper goods; and Steve Duell will do the cooking. The Booster Club will donate the buns and cheese. Darla Mosbarger will call Booster Club members for donations of chips and cookies.

New Business: Brad Schields read a letter from Kim Artzer, Cheerleading Sponsor, requesting a donation to help with spirit items for the school/students. It was moved and seconded to pay the cheerleaders \$50.

It was discussed that Fred Hall will contact Mary Porterfield about sending out the yearly letter to the organizations explaining that each group is entitled to \$50 from the Booster Club.

There was discussion from the club concerning the following committees:

Membership: It was discussed that the club has had very good response on new memberships. It was also discussed to place a fall sports ad in the newspaper as a membership boost, similar to the ad placed in the newspaper for the soap scrimmage. It was moved and seconded to spend up to \$40 for the ad.

Merchandise: Brad Schields announced that he received some new clothing items and cowboy stickers.

Spirit and Hospitality: No discussion.

Ways and Means: Brad Schields gave an update on the chairs being reupholstered in the conference room. One chair is in the process of being reupholstered as a sample using leftover material. There is no charge for the material and the Booster Club will be responsible for paying the labor.

The next meeting will be October 15, 2007, at 6:30 P.M. in the High School cafeteria. Meeting was adjourned.
